## **ROAD CLOSURE DETAILS**

#### Hard Closure:

**Thursday, April 27, 2023**, Rudee Loop at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street will be closed to the public. Residents living or visiting their guests in Rudee Loop will have access to their buildings. There will be no access through Rudee Loop, to include vehicular traffic, pedestrian traffic, and the bike path from Rudee Bridge to the boardwalk will be closed to the public.

#### Daily estimated road closing times for the weekend:

**10:00 AM - Friday, April 28, 2023** – Restricted access of Atlantic Ave from 17<sup>th</sup> to Rudee Loop. Employees, residents, businesses, hotels, and restaurants will be given passes to get to their destination. Use the 200 blocks between Atlantic Ave and Pacific Ave at 9<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Streets to gain access to the closed areas of Atlantic Ave. See page 2 to get passes for your establishment

**10:00 AM - Saturday, April 29, 2023** - Restricted access of Atlantic Ave from 17<sup>th</sup> to Rudee Loop. Employees, residents, businesses, hotels, and restaurants will be given passes to get to their destination. Use the 200 blocks between Atlantic Ave and Pacific Ave at 9<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Streets to gain access to the closed areas of Atlantic Ave. See page 2 to get passes for your establishment.

**10:00 AM - Friday, April 30, 2023** - Restricted access of Atlantic Ave from 17<sup>th</sup> to Rudee Loop. Employees, residents, businesses, hotels, and restaurants will be given passes to get to their destination. Use the 200 blocks between Atlantic Ave and Pacific Ave at 9<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Streets to gain access to the closed areas of Atlantic Ave. See page 2 to get passes for your establishment.

9:00 PM – No vehicle traffic will be allowed on Atlantic Ave after this time on Friday, Saturday, & Sunday.

2:00 AM - Atlantic Ave will re-open to vehicle traffic
